## Non-Literal Uses of Κεφαλη (Kephalē) in the New Testament

## Special Case: κεφαλήν γωνίας (kephalēn gonias)

<u>Matt. 21:42</u> Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: "The stone the builders rejected has become the **capstone**; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes'?

<u>Mark 12:10</u> Haven't you read this scripture: "The stone the builders rejected has become the **capstone**;

<u>Luke 20:17</u> Jesus looked directly at them and asked, "Then what is the meaning of that which is written: "The stone the builders rejected has become the **capstone**?

<u>Acts 4:11</u> He is "'the stone you builders rejected, which has become the **capstone**.'

<u>1Pet. 2:7</u> Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the **capstone**,"

## Other Uses

<u>1Cor. 11:3</u> Now I want you to realize that the **head** of every man is Christ, and the **head** of the woman is man, and the **head** of Christ is God.

<u>Eph. 1:22</u> And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be **head** over everything for the church,

<u>Eph. 4:15</u> Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the **Head**, that is, Christ.

<u>Eph. 5:23</u> For the husband is the **head** of the wife as Christ is the **head** of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior.

<u>Col. 1:18</u> And he is the **head** of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.

<u>Col. 2:9</u> For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, <u>10</u> and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the **head** over every power and authority.

<u>Col. 2:19</u> He has lost connection with the **Head**, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.
